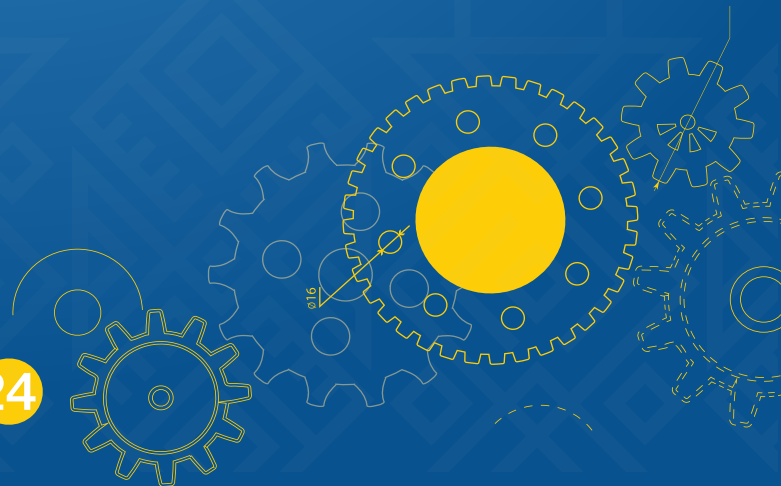

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT.

I would like to begin by expressing my deepest gratitude to all UIPE members for entrusting me with the honor of serving as your President. Your confidence in my leadership is humbling, and I am committed to serving our Institution with integrity and purpose. As your President, I pledge to lead alongside the Council with the highest standards of professionalism, guided by the Ethical Code of Conduct we have embraced.

Strategic Focus Areas (2024–2026)

To address institutional challenges and meet membership expectations, the focus for the next two years is enshrined in twelve Strategic Focus Areas (SFAs) under three pillars: Membership Growth, Retention and Development; Institutional Development and Sustainability; and Public Engagement. The 12 SFAs include:

1. Increase UIPE Membership to over 10,000 Members by 2026
2. Provide Enhanced Member-Focused Trainings to All Membership Categories
3. Conduct Member-Centric Advocacy for All
4. Technology House Development (THD) Project
5. Broaden UIPE Finance Resource Base
6. Strengthen Engineering for Socio-Economic Transformation
7. Foster and Consolidate Local and International Partnerships
8. Strengthen STEM Research and Innovation
9. Improve UIPE Visibility and Corporate Image
10. Influence Policy Matters of Engineering

11. Strengthen Institutional Operations at UIPE Secretariat and Branches
12. Enhance Mentorship, Apprenticeship, and Career Guidance Initiatives

Membership Updates

A recent survey conducted among our members revealed that limited resources discourage membership, particularly among early-career engineers. To address these challenges and encourage membership growth in line with SFA 01, key reforms have been introduced to ease joining UIPE and registering with the Engineers Registration Board:

Abolition of Graduate Membership Waiver Fees:

The UGX 800,000 fee previously charged to applicants for Corporate membership who had not been Graduate members has been removed.

Flexible CPD Requirements:

Graduate members can now fulfill the CPD requirement for Corporate membership by completing any three CPDs of their choice, instead of the previously mandatory Career and Technical Report Writing CPD.

Reduced Membership Application Fees:

Membership fees across all categories have been reduced to make UIPE membership more affordable. Details are provided in the table below.

These initiatives are designed to support early-career engineers and ensure a smoother pathway to professional growth and development.

As of 31st August 2024, UIPE membership stood at 7,468. By 30th November 2024, this number had risen to 8,399, reflecting a 12% increase. This growth also accounts for 37% of the two-year membership target.



I am proud to announce that the Federation of African Engineering Organizations (FAEO) General Assembly has voted UIPE to host the Africa Engineering Week 2025 and General Assembly in November 2025. I thank everyone who supported our bid and urge everyone to plan to attend.

Member Opportunities: Institutional Engagements

Over the past four months, the Institution has actively connected its members to influential platforms, ensuring they play pivotal roles in shaping policies, standards, and practices across various sectors. These engagements exemplify the opportunities available to our members:

Adjudication and Expert Advisory Services

From September to December 2024, the Institution actively engaged in providing adjudication and expert advisory services, involving over 15 registered engineers. During this period, we handled seven adjudication cases across various sectors, including infrastructure, healthcare, and education. Additionally, we recommended experts in mechanization and agricultur-

al engineering to support specialized disputes. These efforts highlight the Institution's dedication to professionalism and its role as a trusted partner in advancing engineering excellence in Uganda.

Nominations to Committees

Education and Training Institutions:

Representatives were nominated to the Governing Councils of Uganda Technical College Kyema and Kyambogo University.

Government Ministries:

The Ministry of Finance, Planning, and Economic Development requested nominees for both the Investment Committee and the Public Sector Audit Committees, demonstrating the trust placed in our Institution's expertise.

Regulatory and Oversight Bodies:

Engineers were nominated to review finalists for the National Building Control Awards under the National Building Review Board and to participate in UNABSEC's Nomination and Elections Committee.

Participation in Workshops and Conferences

National Initiatives:

Members represented the Institution at key events, including the URA Integrity Forum, the Refugees Employment Roundtable Workshop by the Norwegian Refugee Council, and the Government of Uganda and ITU Project Closure event.

Regional and International Platforms:

Invitations were received from the Africa Women in Arbitration Symposium and the 37th Convention of the Institution of Engineers of Kenya. The Institution also participated in the Global Engineering Conference and Executive Council meetings by WFEO in Kigali, Rwanda.

These collaborations affirm the Institution's role in fostering professional growth and impact for its members.

Thank you for participating in the recently concluded SWOT analysis of UIPE. Your feedback is invaluable, and we are committed to addressing the identified weaknesses, leveraging opportunities, and building on our strengths. Read on to explore the strides we've made over the past four months.

Enhancing Employability through Innovation and Skills Development:

To enhance the employability of young engineers through innovation and skills development, we conducted various activities, including Intellectual Property (IP) and Innovation Management Awareness Campaigns targeting 3rd- and 4th-year engineering students. We organized a 4-day boot camp for 18 students from select universities, in collaboration with Makerere University Unipod, led by Dr. Catherine Mbidde Ikiror.

Research and Innovation:

In our commitment to fostering research and innovation while promoting inclusivity, we are in the final stages of awarding four prototypes from previous Africa Catalyst Projects. Additionally, six new innovations developed by women and individuals with disabilities under the current Africa Catalyst Phase 5 will also be recognized and supported.

Advancing Engineering Innovation:

As an engineering professional institution, we are uniquely positioned to enhance the contribution of engineering professionals to the innovation value chain in Uganda and beyond. Achieving this requires a robust institutional framework. In this regard, we have partnered with Innovate Labs Africa (ILA) to develop an institutional policy for research, intellectual property (IP), and innovation management. This policy is currently under review by the RIG Committee and Council.

Promoting Occupational Safety and Health (OSH):

In collaboration with key industry players, including the Ministry of Labor, Gender, and Social Development (MoLGSD) and the Uganda Manufacturers Association (UMA), we conducted nationwide visits to select manufacturing industries to assess their Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) practices. These efforts culminated in an award ceremony in October 2024, recognizing the most compliant companies. The event was officiated by the Minister for the Elderly, MoLGSD.

We wouldn't have achieved much without the support through the years of our development partners, Royal Academy of Engineering UK through their various programs. It's evident that we have continued to enhance our visibility but more still needs to be done. Our signage still needs to be made more visible and our office premises also needs to be made more appealing. I believe with your dedicated support we will be able to achieve all these in the coming months. However, the year did not go without challenges; in a very sad note we lost 3 members of the Institution during the quarter namely; Eng. Frank Magoba, Mr. Busobozi William and Mr. Kirungi Tom. May their souls continue to rest in Eternal Peace. Amen.

Bureaucratic delays, outdated systems, and centralized registration processes frustrate members.

4. Visibility Issues:

Low public and media presence reduces UIPE's ability to attract members and enhance its image.

5. Professional Development Gaps:

Insufficient resources for training and research, coupled with low member participation, undermine the quality of UIPE's programs.

6. Regulatory and Ethical Challenges:

Weak enforcement frameworks and limited awareness of the revised code of ethics hinder ethical compliance.

7. Technological Limitations:

Slow adoption of modern technology impacts efficiency and member accessibility.

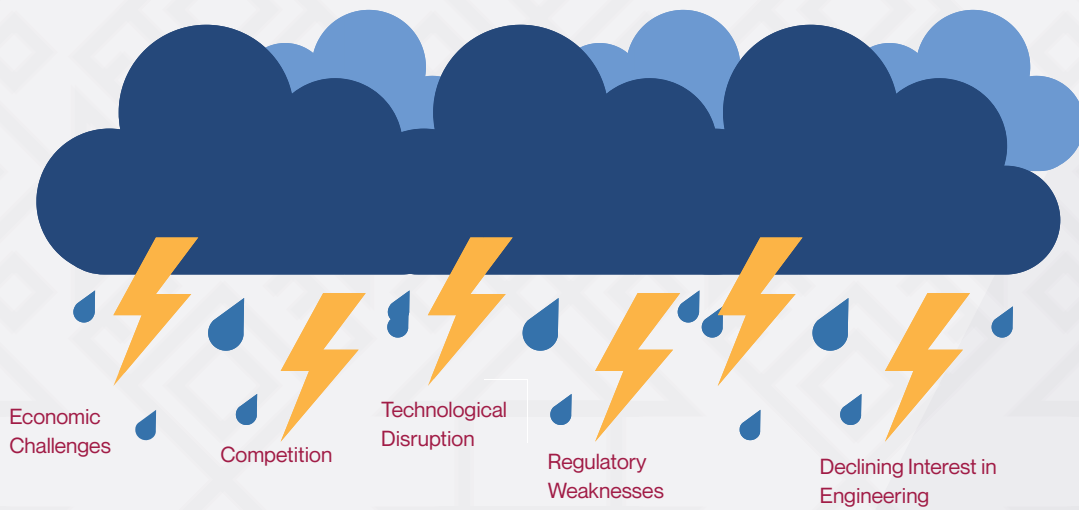

UIPE Conducts a Four-Day Boot Camp on Innovation and Intellectual Property Management

The Uganda Institution of Professional Engineers (UIPE) successfully conducted a 4-day Residential Boot camp on Innovation and Intellectual Property Management from 17th to 20th December 2024 at Essella Country Hotel, Kira.

The boot camp was attended by 18 final-year student innovators from Kabale University, Gulu University, Busitema University, Makerere University Kampala, Mbarara University of Science and Technology, and Muteesa I Royal University.

The facilitators, Dr. Cathy Mbidde Ikiror, Ag. Manager of Makerere University Innovation Hub, and Mr. Bakundana Ismail Adam, a Business and Legal Consultant, equipped participants with essential knowledge and skills in the following areas:

- Innovation readiness and ecosystems
- Pitch deck preparation
- Design thinking for problem-solving
- Customer needs analysis
- Technology roadmaps and emerging technologies for innovation
- Team development
- Business model strategic direction and the Business Model Canvas
- Legal issues, budgeting, funding, sustainability, and implementation plans

The training was organized by UIPE in collaboration with Innovent Labs Africa and the University of the West of Scotland and was sponsored by the Royal Academy of Engineering, UK.



HIGHLIGHTS FROM OUR CPD SESSIONS

The Reinforced Concrete Design and Analysis CPD Training

The Training was held on the 24th and 25th of October 2024 at Hotel Africana, Kampala. The training was facilitated by Eng. Prof. Jackson A. Mwakali, who covered a wide range of essential topics to enhance participants' professional knowledge and skills in reinforced concrete design.

Key topics covered included: Introduction to Concrete, Material Behavior and Quality Control, Structural

Analysis and Design, Detailing and Computation and Computer-Aided Design (CAD).

This training provided an in-depth understanding of reinforced concrete design principles, equipping participants with advanced techniques and tools for modern structural engineering practice. 92 People attended the training and ProtaStructure software was installed on their laptops.



The Career and Technical Report Writing training

The Career and Technical Report Writing training was held on 14th and 15th November 2024 at Royal Suites Hotel, Bugolobi. The training, facilitated by Eng. Ben Kyemba and Eng. Vincent Ochwo Olie, provided participants with essential skills in preparing high-quality career and technical reports.

Key topics covered included:

- Fundamentals of career and technical report writing
- Common mistakes in reports and how to avoid them
- Cross-cutting issues in engineering reporting
- Presentation skills and oral defense techniques
- Engineers' Code of Conduct

A total of 120 participants were equipped with skills on how to write an acceptable career and technical report and effectively present it before the Joint Admissions Committee (JAC) for consideration for UIPE membership and ERB registration.



The Energy Efficiency and Climate Change Management CPD training

The Energy Efficiency and Climate Change Management CPD training was successfully conducted online via Zoom on 28th and 29th November 2024. A total of 61 participants attended the training. The training aimed to equip participants with essential knowledge and practical skills in energy efficiency and climate change management. The training was facilitated by Eng. Ariho Denis and Dr. Geoffrey Baka-bulindi under the following objectives:

1. Develop a comprehensive understanding of energy efficiency and climate change management concepts.
2. Identify and explore opportunities for energy efficiency improvements in buildings and industrial settings.
3. Acquire skills in conducting energy audits and implementing energy-saving measures.
4. Understand the critical role of climate change management in achieving sustainable development.

The training provided valuable insights into best practices, innovative strategies, and actionable steps for enhancing energy efficiency and mitigating climate change impacts.

The Technical Audit and Value-for-Money Audit for Engineering Infrastructure Projects CPD training

The Technical Audit and Value-for-Money Audit for Engineering Infrastructure Projects CPD training was successfully conducted online on 19th and 20th December 2024. The training attracted 59 participants, who benefited from insightful discussions and practical knowledge shared by expert facilitators Eng. Steven Serunjogi, Eng. Ben Kyemba, and Eng. Vincent Ochwo, with Eng. Kimeze Ssebuga leading the discussions.

The training aimed to enhance participants' understanding and application of technical and financial auditing in engineering infrastructure projects.

The key objectives were to:

- Understand the principles and significance of technical audits and value-for-money audits in engineering projects.
- Identify and effectively apply tools and techniques for conducting technical audits and value-for-money assessments.
- Develop skills in reporting and presenting audit findings in a clear and actionable manner.
- Enhance participants' confidence and competence in performing technical audits and ensuring financial accountability in infrastructure projects.

The training provided a platform for knowledge sharing, practical case studies, and interactive discussions, equipping professionals with the necessary skills to improve audit processes and promote efficiency in engineering projects.

The “Bridging the Gap: Transitioning from Engineering Academia to Industry” webinar

The “Bridging the Gap: Transitioning from Engineering Academia to Industry” webinar was held on Tuesday, 10th December 2024, at 6:00 PM via Zoom. The session was facilitated by Eng. 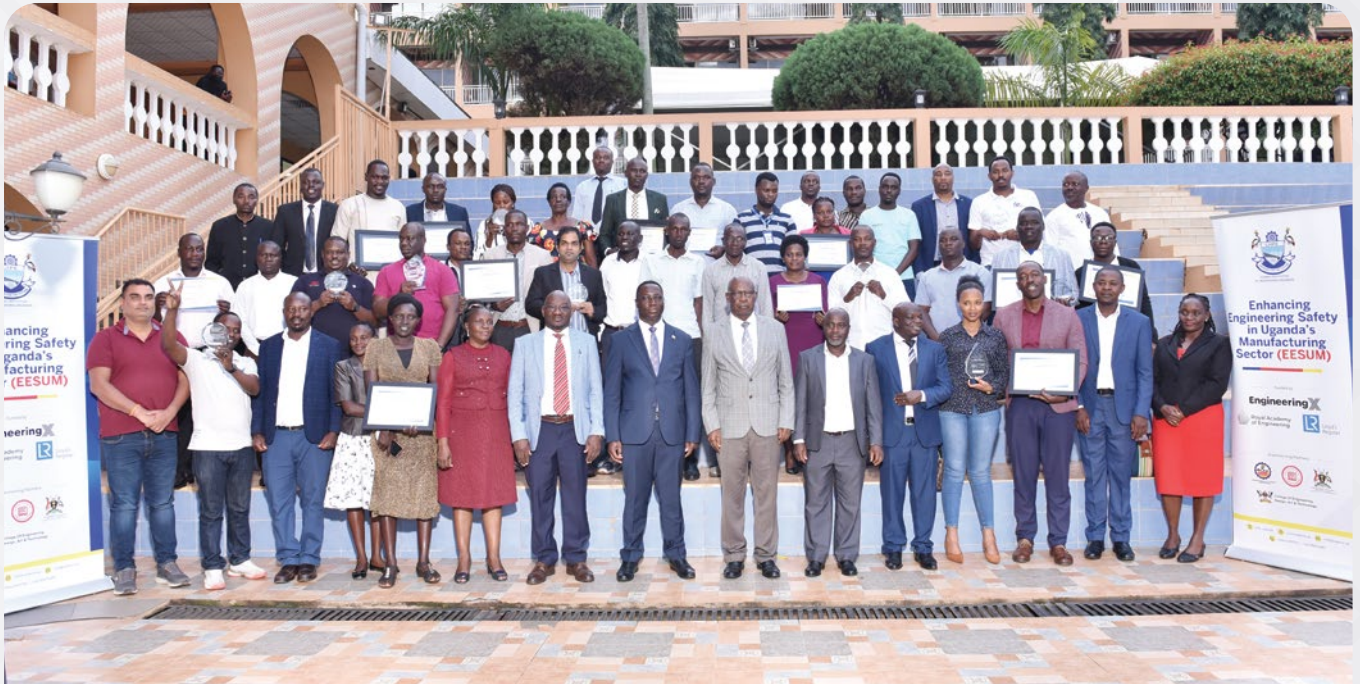
The facilitators shared their career journeys, highlighting key challenges and strategies for a successful transition. They emphasized the importance of:

The African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA): A Turning Point for Africa

The launch of the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) marks a significant milestone in Africa's development journey. This initiative aims to transform the continent into a single market, allowing free movement of people, goods, and services across borders. Rehabilitation Of Karuma Bridge: Revitalizing A Vital National Infrastructure

Karuma Bridge, located at the edge of Murchison Falls National Park, approximately 270 km north of Kampala along the Kampala-Gulu highway in Kiryandongo District, was constructed in 1963, just a year after Uganda's independence. Its primary purpose was to improve transportation and economic connectivity across the country, particularly in the West Nile and Northern Uganda regions, and it remains a key gateway for the area.

Over time, the bridge has experienced significant deterioration due to the stresses from increased traffic loads. Issues such as cracks, spalled deck soffits, broken expansion joints, and damaged elastomeric bearings have compromised its structural integrity. Further deterioration has included exposed reinforcing bars and the corrosion of steel elements. Additionally, safety



concerns have been raised due to steep gradients and sharp curves at the bridge's approach roads, emphasizing the urgent need for rehabilitation.

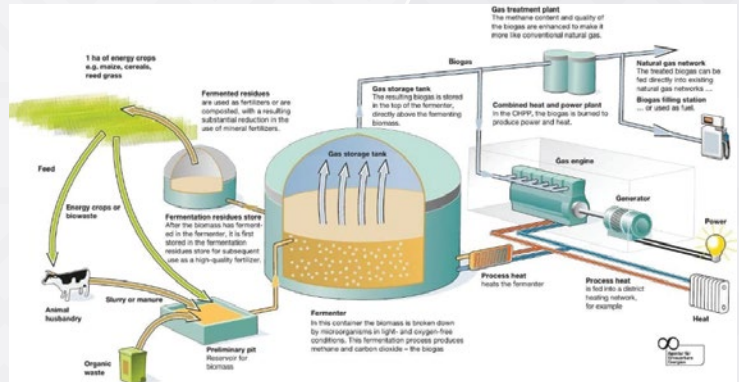
Adaptation To The Use Of Biogas As An Energy-saving Incentive

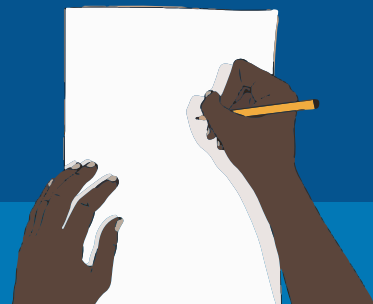
